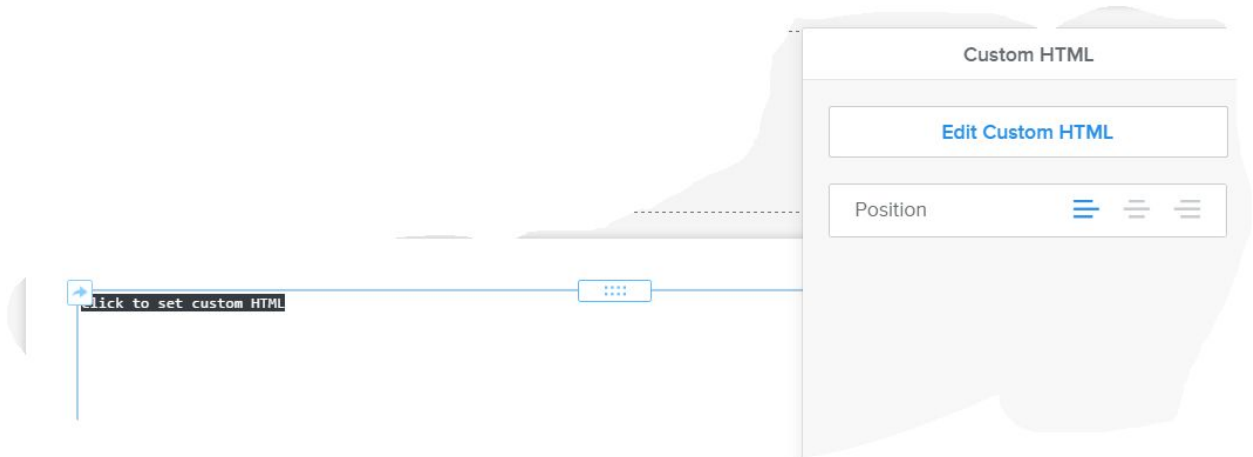
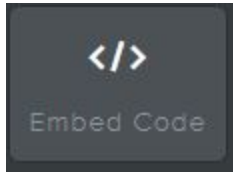


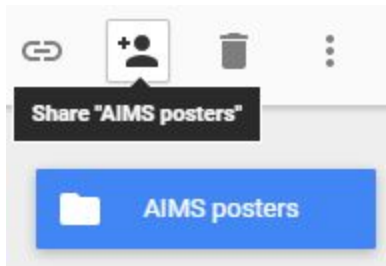
# How to Embed Google Folders on Website

Pull the “Embed Code” over to your page



## Make sure your folder is “Shareable”

1. Click on Folder, then go to the top and click on the Person



2. Click “Get Shareable Link”



3. In the next prompt click "More" - Click the circle next to "Public on the Web"

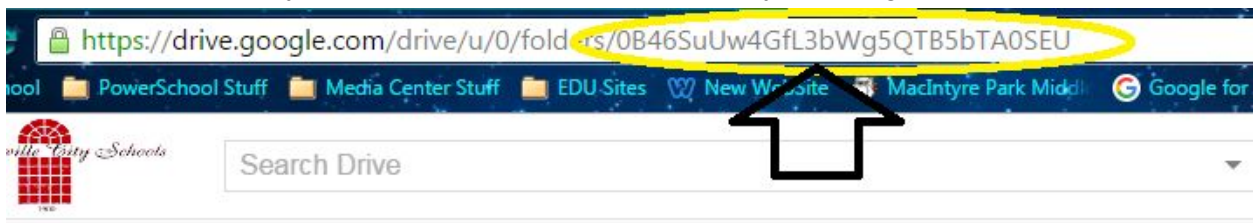
