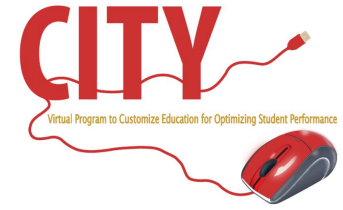

What is the C.I.T.Y. Virtual Program?

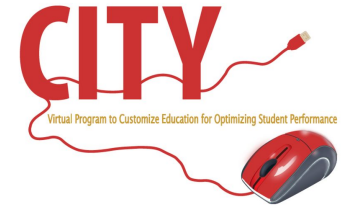
- ❖ Customizing Instruction To Yield Scholars

- ❖ Technologically prepared



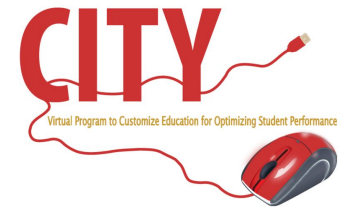
Full Virtual vs Hybrid Student

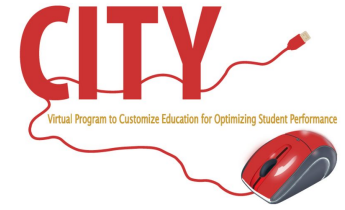

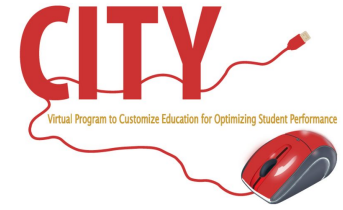

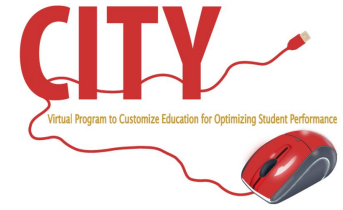

Enrollment

- ❖ Application and teacher recommendation
- ❖ Transfer students will need to also fill out a TSC enrollment packet and provide transcripts
- ❖ Students enrolling in the Virtual Program will be required to be academically on track for graduation and in good academic standing from prior school year

Attendance

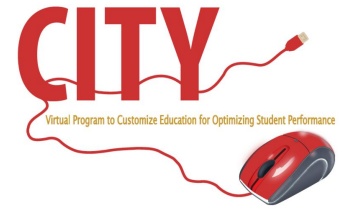


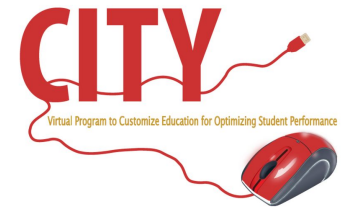
- ❖ “Open” Campus
- ❖ Must coordinate weekly schedule with Program Coordinator
- ❖ Student is not on track, then will be required to be in lab until caught up with passing grade.
- ❖ Failure to follow agreed schedule will constitute skipping and follow consequences in handbook. Multiple violations will result in removal from the program into a brick and mortar class.
- ❖ Full time virtual students will need to let Program Coordinator know prior to coming to campus and must sign in at the school office. If caught anywhere on campus other than lab, could result in removal from program.

Grading Policy

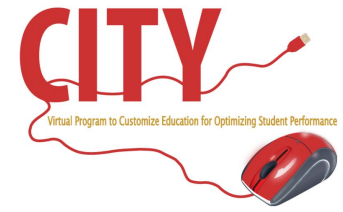
Class assignments are spread out over the Virtual academic calendar year and consist of:

- ❖ Projects - 10%
- ❖ Lessons - 20%
- ❖ Quizzes - 30%
- ❖ Tests - 40%

A semester grade will be given on report cards at the end of the first semester. Parents can use their parent login to check progress throughout the year.

Due Dates

- ❖ Used to pace the student to finish on time
- ❖ Students may work ahead of due dates
- ❖ Once a due date has passed and work was not completed, a zero will be entered for the assignment until the student has completed the work.



Probation & Dismissal

If a student falls behind:

- ❖ 2 weeks - student will have a conference with the Virtual Program Coordinator
- ❖ 4 weeks - OW account will be suspended until a parent conference is set up
- ❖ 6 weeks - dismissal from the program and placed in brick and mortar classes

At the end of the first semester, all work not completed up to the midpoint of the class will receive a zero. A student will be placed on academic probation if his/her semester grade falls below a 70.

If a student's semester average falls below a 60, the student will be dismissed from the program and placed in brick and mortar classes at their respective school.
